## **MEETING ENTRY**

- The entry fee for each class at this meeting and practice day including GST is \$600.00 per kart.
- Practice only on Saturday for extra kart \$50 per kart
- Licence requirements: AASA Karting Licence or AASA Event Licence
- Drivers must complete a Driver Registration form
- Drivers must be a minimum of 15 (fifteen) years of age.
- Drivers under the age of 18 must wear a minors patch (provided by club) – 1 inch below their left knee of their race suit to indicate they require a guardian with them to be addressed by an official / participant.
- Cross entering of Drivers is not permitted.
- Payment must be received prior to the event commencement.
- SEK reserve the right to refuse entry to:
  - o Any team or driver where any outstanding funds are owed to the club and/ or
  - o Such entry may be deemed not in the best interest of the club; and / or
  - o Attendance at a race meeting by a team / driver may provide a negative impact to the event / officials / other competitors.

## **MINIMUM ENTRIES**

- The minimum number of entries per class shall be nominated by the organiser for each round. If insufficient entries are received the event may be cancelled at the discretion of the organiser.

## **COMPETITION CLASSES:**

## MEETING FORMAT & CONDITIONS:

DRIVERS:	<p>Minimum number of drivers for the event is: TWO (2)</p> <p>Driver stint length as per SEK 2024 Rule book.</p> <p>Driver protective apparel requirements as per the SEK 2024 rule book.</p> <p>Driver's briefing is compulsory for ALL Drivers.</p>
PRACTICE:	As per the meeting schedule
STARTING GRID:	Will be determined by Computerised Random Grid Allocation
RACE/S:	Saturday - 1 x SEVEN (7) hours
POINTS & PRIZES:	As per SEK 2024 Rule Book
CONTROL FUEL REQUIREMENTS:	<p>Regular or Premium Unleaded Fuel that does not contain Ethanol, purchases less than seven (7) days prior to the meeting (receipt of purchase must be presented with fuel)</p> <p>The amount of fuel required for this meeting is 40 ltrs.</p>
TYRES:	<p>Any number of prescribed tyres may be used in practice sessions.</p> <p>Once qualifying commences only:</p> <p>ONE (1) set of prescribed slick tyres for the entire event. ONE (1) sets of prescribed wet weather tyres may be used for the entire event (only once the meeting is declared open)</p> <p>PRESCRIBED TYRES: SLICK TYRES – DUNLOP SL1A WET TYRES – Unilli UN519/UN520</p> <p>Damaged tyre replacement – as per the SEK 2024 rule book.</p>
TRANSPONDERS:	Each kart requires a mylaps transponder. The club has a limited number of transponders that can be hired for \$50 each per round.

<p>PIT / FUEL STOPS:</p>	<p>COMPULSORY PIT STOPS:</p> <p>Race 1 – Twelve (12) including a minimum of four (4) fuel stops.</p> <p>Pit stops are allowed and counted in the first 30 minutes of the race, but NOT in the last 30 minutes of each race. For a stop to be counted the kart must cross the start/finish line twice (2) under race conditions. (Green flag / start of race is counted as one (1) crossing)</p> <p>Pit stops are not counted in a weight stop.</p>
<p>MECHANICAL BREAKDOWN LANE:</p>	<p>Mechanical breakdown lane will not be in use for this meeting. All repairs must be carried out outside of pitlane area which will be clearly defined in drivers briefing.</p>
<p>PIT LANE:</p>	<p>Speed limit - up to 13 km per hour (or what is deemed by the clerk of the course to be a safe speed.</p>
<p>VIRTUAL SAFETY KART:</p>	<p>Will be used for this event. Procedure as per SEK 2024 Rule book.</p>
<p>KART RETRIEVAL:</p>	<p>Is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Pit crew must only enter track when permitted by an official and only if wearing a HIGH VIS apparel on the upper torso.</p>
<p>RACE RESTART PROCEDURE:</p>	<p>As per the SEK 2024 Rule book.</p>



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
